Wreaths Across America fundraising campaign & more



We will be help prepare for The Resource Center's Baby Bottle Drive. They will have drinks and snacks and fellowship as we gather for our Day of Service. If you have an extra pair of scissors, please bring a pair! This will be at Chris and Bill's home – 708 River View Dr, Greeley.

Our speaker will be Rachel Pinkston from the City of Greeley Homeless Solutions Department. The City of Greeley recently adopted the Housing First model to address the homeless population.

This model believes that those experiencing homelessness must have the security of a roof over their head to back on their feet. In addition to providing housing, the model includes wrap-around services such as case management, counseling, substance use treatment and more.

Each year, about 820 people become homeless in Greeley. Of those 820 people, 160 will experience long-term homelessness. The current homeless response system lacks the capacity to support everyone in need.

Come hear Rachel explain the details of this program and its effects on our community.
